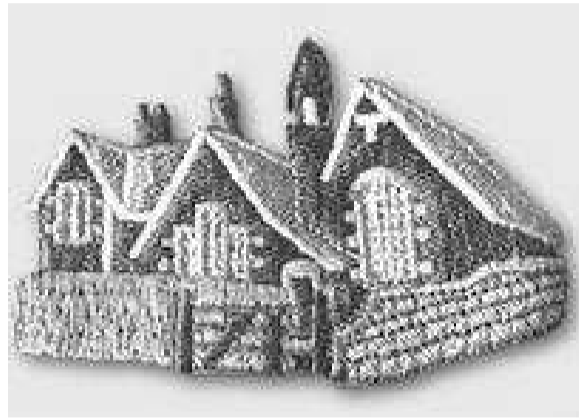

Relationship and Sex Education

As in previous years, the growing and changing unit plans under the umbrella of RSE are not used in a stand-alone way and forms part of a balanced delivery including wider conversations and discussion as well as the children having opportunity to ask questions, if they wish. The main focus in Reception, Year 1 and 2 is understanding that we change as we grow and to understand the correct language for certain body parts. Year 3-6 will develop their understanding of the changes they will go through as they go through puberty which can happen in Primary school or prepare them for secondary school. Any questions, will be answered factually and in an age appropriate manner and each pupil's privacy will be respected.
